We have had a couple of busy months here in Mexico. We went to the river after our church service on Easter Sunday and baptized four people, including our son David Paul. We have a couple more that want to be baptized in the coming weeks. Please pray for these individuals to remain faithful and obedient to what God would have them do.

At the end of April, we celebrated our annual kid's day. We had several kids come to hear about Jesus. Most of our kids that come are somehow related to the deaf. Most do not necessarily have an excellent Christian influence at home so coming to church is their only chance to hear about Jesus. One such kid is the brother of one of our deaf. He is a good kid with a lot of energy. He is always eager to learn the Bible verses and participate in his class. Please pray for him and the other children who come that they will trust Jesus as their savior and grow up willing to serve God.

We will be leaving for our family deaf camp on the last week of July. As of right now, 12 people want to go. We have made the deposit to rent a fifteen-passenger van to carry us to camp. We want to thank the churches and individuals who have made it possible for everyone to be able to go. Please pray for our travels; it is about a ten-hour drive to where we will be going. Please pray for those who will be going that the Lord will touch their hearts and they will be able to apply what they learn to their lives.

We want to take this time to thank each of you for your prayers and support of our ministry. We would not be able to do the ministry here if it were not for each of you. We are also thankful to God, who has put us in the ministry and is always faithful to us. Please pray for us for wisdom as we take care of different things here that God will give us wisdom and peace in all decisions that we make
