I just returned from another visit to our churches in Guatemala and Mexico. WHAT A BLESSING! I was accompanied by my nephew Evangelist Adam Davis and Zac Whiting with KEEP YOUR HEART ministries. I met them at the airport in Guatemala city with Pastor Salomon Gomez and Pastor Benny Tahay. We traveled all day to be able to cross over into Mexico the next day. We spent most of the day going house to house and then had a wonderful meeting with Pastor Adrian Gonzalez and the Faro de Luz church. The team did a great job singing and Adam gave a powerful word from James 1. If you can ever have these guys in your church or to work with your youth don't miss that opportunity. After Mexico the next day we did evangelism in the city of Jacaltenango with Pastor German Sylvestre using the 'See 3 Things God Can Not Do" board. Many heard the Gospel. The next day we traveled 8 hours to go to Xejuyup. We did evangelism in the market center, later we worked with the youth in San Bernardino with Iglesia Bautista Puerta Abierta, then more evangelism in the city park in front of the police station, followed by a Bible Study back up in Xejuyup. We also traveled up in the mountains to visit a couple previously in our Xejuyup church that have moved there in Tzamjuyup. (Called the nose or tip of Xejuyup.) We prayed with them about possibility of starting a mission work there. Sunday was filled with services in both churches. This was a blessed time of for this missionary to "see how they do" in our churches. I also want to include some recent messages sent by a couple of our pastors since I was with them.

Note from Benny Tahay: (translated)

With the children we have always had our regular activities. Every time we have class with the children we have always bought sweets, cookies, sweets and others so that they feel happy.

And last week we were able to get a cable and buy to connect to a computer, today we loaned a computer to be able to watch the movie with the children and it was excellent, we prepared a special part for them after watching the movie. Today 25 children arrived. There are others who could not all arrive

because of the rains very early it rains. There are some who came after everything was over.

I have also been speaking with brother Melvin. (Melvin lives in Chocala) He decided to come visit me at home, because he likes to come to my house. And we were talking and he came to ask various questions about the Bible. He is working a lot now because he has debt to pay. And he said that he lacks a little to pay his debt, when he finishes paying his debt, he wants to study the word one day a week constantly. Praying for this one.

Brother Luis I have been visiting him and praying for their lives he is sad and he sends greetings to you. We are constantly working with them and seeing how to reach others there close to Luis. (They live in San Juan Maza)

With Manuela and her husband. (They live in Tzamjuyup) I'm talking to them now so I can have a talk about starting to go upstairs with them to teach.

They have not had time these days because they are fixing some things, possibly they come down this week or the next here in Xejuyup visiting my family.

We are working to be able to take the gospel in the places where we have the connections now and to be able to reach more people and more works for the Lord. My heart is to arrive in the various places around Xejuyup and more works for the Lord.

I ask prayers for all this Pastor.
